

SAFE PASSAGE

Safe Passage gives abused children a voice and enables the healing process by acting as a single source of contact for medical, investigative, and legal services.

CSHF 4 Grants since 2017

- Program grant to expand access to medical exams for abused children
- Capital grant for co-located Children's Advocacy Center
- Two general operating grants for core programming

MILESTONES

- * Successfully led a \$2.7M capital campaign to become the first co-located Children's Advocacy Center in Colorado
- * Co-location with partners provides a child-centered, coordinated response to abuse cases
- * Celebrating 30 years as an authoritative community resource for abuse and trauma



IMPACT

- * Safe Passage has served more than 40,000 primary and secondary victims of abuse
- * In 2023, Safe Passage provided services to 701 primary abuse victims and 691 secondary victims
- * 98.7% of clients agreed that Safe Passage provided appropriate resources to support the child and respond to their needs in the days and weeks ahead
- * 100% of partner organizations believed that clients served through the center benefit from the collaborative approach of the multidisciplinary team
