Founded in 1968, Catholic Charities of Central Colorado is one of the region's largest providers of integrated human services. Through healthcare access, behavioral health, housing, employment, food security, and family support services, the organization helps individuals and families move toward long-term stability and well-being.



MILESTONES

- **Expanded Healthcare Access.** Strengthened healthcare navigation, community nursing, and provider partnerships serving individuals experiencing homelessness and poverty.
- **Expanded Behavioral Health Services (2024).** Invested in clinical leadership, staffing, and insurance billing capacity to increase access to counseling and therapeutic services.
- **Behavioral Health Became the "Golden Thread."** Embedded behavioral health more deeply across services.
- **Opened Hunt Family Housing (2025).** Launched a 24-unit transitional housing community for families experiencing homelessness.
- **Strengthened Organizational Infrastructure.** Expanded data systems, billing infrastructure, service coordination, and outcome measurement capacity.

Expanded Access to Behavioral Health Care.

Expanded counseling services increased access for individuals and families facing economic hardship, housing instability, trauma, and other challenges.

Improved Healthcare Access.

Navigation, referrals, transportation assistance, and direct client support help clients overcome barriers and access needed medical, dental, vision, and prescription services.

Increased Housing Stability

Early Hunt Family Housing outcomes include:

- 8 families transitioned to permanent housing
- 100% increased food security
- 94% established insurance and primary care
- 71% improved mental health

CSHF Support

CSHF investments helped Catholic Charities expand healthcare access, build a sustainable behavioral health program, support development of Hunt Family Housing, and strengthen the infrastructure needed to sustain long-term impact.

“We've become more willing to ask, *'What if we did?'* Hunt Family Housing grew out of that. We knew there was a need, but it took the belief that we could do something about it—and partners like Colorado Springs Health Foundation willing to say, *'Yeah, you can.'*”
