Kidpower equips youth ages 4–18 and the adults who support them with personal safety, boundary-setting, and healthy relationship skills. Through experiential, trauma-informed programs delivered in schools and community settings, Kidpower works upstream to prevent abuse before it occurs.



MILESTONES

- Moved into co-located Children's Advocacy Center (2021) which improved coordination across systems and strengthened partnerships with law enforcement and child service providers.
- Hired first daytime Program Coordinator (2022), expanded staffing, strengthened instructor training and improved compensation/benefits.
- Launched ADA-compliant, bilingual website to reduce barriers and improve staff efficiency through automated enrollment and communication systems.
- Redesigned curriculum for online engagement and developed hybrid delivery models to expand reach.
- Expanded programming for teens and neurodiverse youth and strengthened focus on technology safety.
