Teller Senior Coalition (TSC) provides transportation, nutrition support, homemaking, caregiver respite, case management, and home safety services to older adults and vulnerable residents in Teller and Western El Paso Counties. In a rural region with limited public transportation, TSC helps residents access healthcare, food, and essential services while maintaining independence.



MILESTONES

- Expanded transportation services, becoming a critical link to healthcare, food, and essential services for Teller County residents.
- Expanded healthcare access for adults under age 60, increasing rides from 80 to 376 between 2024 and 2025.
- Developed local shuttle routes connecting rural mountain communities to Woodland Park and essential services.
- Strengthened partnerships with hospitals and discharge planners, helping connect seniors to transportation, food, medical equipment, and in-home supports following hospitalization.
- Completed the organization's first independent audit and strengthened financial systems and organizational infrastructure.

Healthcare Access. Transportation helps residents access chemotherapy, dialysis, physical therapy, specialty care, prescriptions, and medical equipment.

Aging in Place. Integrated transportation, nutrition, homemaking, respite, and home safety services help residents remain safely in their homes longer.

Food Security. 80% of meal recipients reported worrying less about having enough food, and 83% reported access to food they otherwise could not obtain.

Client Satisfaction. 96%-100% of survey respondents rated services excellent or good across major program areas.

CSHF Support

How CSHF Made a Difference:

- Expanded transportation access for adults under age 60 who lacked other transportation options.
- Strengthened organizational infrastructure through communications and financial system improvements.
- Provided flexible operating support that helped maintain services during funding instability and Medicaid reimbursement delays.
