Tri-Lakes Cares is a community resource center serving individuals and families in northern El Paso County. Through an integrated model, TLC connects neighbors to food, healthcare, transportation, and case management—addressing immediate needs while building long-term stability.



MILESTONES

- Evolved from a traditional food pantry into an integrated service model addressing multiple needs simultaneously
- Expanded the Neighborhood Nurse Center (2016), embedding healthcare access directly within a trusted community setting
- Strengthened partnerships through a “flex office” model, bringing rotating providers on-site (mental health, legal, workforce, disability services)
- Responded to growing demand—households served doubled since 2022
- Purchased land in 2025 to develop a future community hub, co-locating services to reduce barriers and improve access

“There’s been a shift from ‘what program do you need?’ to ‘what’s going on in your life, and how can we help stabilize that?’”
